Community Dining Meals

The Community Dining Meals
Program provides adults 60 years
and older the opportunity to connect
with others while enjoying a hot,
nutritionally-balanced meal. Noontime
meals are served at select locations
around Kitsap County. Reservations
are required by 2:00 pm at least one
business day in advance.

Meals To Go

Meals on Wheels Kitsap offers older adults weekly frozen meal pick-up services at convenient locations throughout the county. Currently clients may choose to pick-up frozen complete meals once a week between 11:45am and 12:15pm at designated locations.

Community Dining Meals and Meals To Go are offered on a donation-only basis to eligible adults age 60 years and over. The suggested donation is \$5.00 per meal.

Home Delivered Meals

Well-balanced and nutritious meals are delivered to adults 60 years and older in Kitsap County who are homebound due to illness or disability and are unable to prepare meals for themselves. Referrals are accepted from individuals, family members, friends, physicians and agencies. Meals are provided on a donation-only basis and participants are asked to contribute as able. The suggested donation is \$5.00 per meal.



Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program

Fresh, nutritious, locally-grown fruits and vegetables are available to qualified low-income seniors, aged 60 years and over, to improve their nutritional status while supporting local farmers. Produce may be purchased with special EBT card at local farmers' markets or delivered directly to homebound seniors between June and October.



Family Caregiver Meals

Home delivered meals can be provided to participants of the Kitsap County Caregiver Support program. Service is available to unpaid family caregivers and their care recipient to provide a break from caregiving responsibilities. This service is available within funding and eligibility limitations. Nutrition Education and Dietary Counseling

A registered dietitian is available for dietary counseling and nutrition education to all Meals on Wheels clients at no charge. The dietitian plans nutritionally balanced meals appropriate for seniors.
